Day 1: (A Tour) Hometown – Vancouver
Airport pick up and transfers to hotel

(B Tour) Hometown – Seattle – Vancouver
Airport pick up and city tour. (3 hours Seattle city tour provided free for all arrivals before 12:00pm only) Tour includes: Lake Washington, Ship Canal and Hiram M. Chittenden Locks, Fish Ladder & Space Needle etc. (admission not included) Transfer to hotel in the afternoon.



Day 2: (A & B Tour) **Victoria one day –(including ferry charges, 1 lunch & admission to Butchart Gardens)**

Morning departure for Vancouver Island by BC Ferries, tour famous Butchart Gardens upon arrival, then proceed to Victoria, visit Victoria's Chinatown, Legislative Building, Inner Harbor, through Beacon Hill Park & stop by "Mile 0". Return to Vancouver in the evening.

OR : Whistler Sightseeing One Day Tour (Sightseeing Gondola optional)

(Reduction of : Adult CAD\$32.00, Child CAD \$29.00)

Morning Transfer from Vancouver to the world famous ski resort of Whistler - which is designated for the 2010 Winter Olympic Site. Day 3: (A & B Tour) Vancouver one day Tour (including Lynne Canyon Suspension Bridge)

Tour begins at Chinatown where you can picture the glamorous history of the early pioneers who arrived from Mainland China to begin a new life here. Then we proceed to Gastown, the place where you'll find some buildings of the 1870's and the rich history behind it. Tour will pass by the Vancouver Trade & Convention Centre, through the 1,000 acres Stanley Park, Lion's Gate Bridge, to the Lynne Canyon Suspension Bridge where you will experience the thrill of crossing a suspension bridge about 150 feet above the Canyon. Afternoon visit Granville Island Farmer's Market & the beautiful sunken garden of Queen Elizabeth Park.
