## Food Fiesta of Myanmar Package (3Days/2Nights)

### Day 01 Arrive Yangon (-/-/D)



Arrive at Yangon International Airport, welcome by our Tour Guide. Transfer to Hotel & check in. Sightseeing to the prime downtown location the center of Yangon. After that, sightseeing Sunset at the Shwedagone Pagoda which is one of the world's most spectacular religious monuments and the golden dome of **Shwedagon Pagoda** rises 98 meters above its base and is covered with 60 tons of pure gold. Dinner at Karaweik Palace Restaurant. (*Thai-Myanmar Buffet with cultural show*). *Overnight at Summit Park View Hotel (Superior room) in Yangon.*

### Day 02 Yangon

**(B/L/D)**



After breakfast, shopping at Bogyoke Market. There are 1,641 shops selling luxury items, handicrafts, foodstuffs, clothing, jewelry, fashion and consumer goods. The market is a square type based and therefore divided into the East wing, West wing, North wing and South wing. The shopping items are not categorized in the respective wings. Looking around and finding the most suitable item would be fun. There are also traditional, Myanmar and Chinese food stalls in the market. Lunch at Local restaurant. After lunch, go to **Capital Hyper Market** for shopping and eating in a food court. After that, go to China Town.

**The Chinatown** of Yangon lies west of the Sule Pagoda which is located in the centre of downtown Yangon. Proceeding west along the Sule Pagoda Road, the 24th, 23rd, 22nd, 20th, 19th and 18th Streets and Bo Ywe, Latha and Sint Oh Dan Roads steaming with traffic are the busiest quarters of the city as it is in Chinatowns in other parts of the world. These roads fall under the Latha Township.

*A variety of restaurants*, gold and jewelery stores, network game centers, cyber café, clothing shops and mini-markets display their wares while roadside food stalls dispense steaming dishes and snacks. Fruit vendors offer fruit in season which include mangoes, durians, mangos teens, pomelos, apples, tangerines, grapes, pears, avocados, lichees, pineapples, rambutan, plums and all kinds of banana, all the year round.

**The Guang Dong Kwan Yin Temple**, established about 170 years ago is located between the busy Latha and 20th Streets. Although the exact date of its construction is not known, it was known to be in existence by the year 1824 and that it was rebuilt in 1868 after being destroyed in a fire. Most of the Chinese live in this part of the city as which forms a town of their own. Business is blooming in this area and it has become a place as a tourist attraction too.

**During the Chinese New Year holiday**, this part of the city is most crowded and red decorations can be seen everywhere. Walking through the Chinatown can give one an amazing experience. Diner at local restaurant. *Overnight at Summit Park View Hotel.*
