## PINK LINE – TOUR ITINERARY

### [Sunday] Copenhagen → Jönköping (330 km)

The day starts with a sightseeing tour of Copenhagen, capital of the Kingdom of Denmark. Reminiscent of childhood memory fairy tales, Hans Christian Andersen's **"The Little Mermaid"** is the inspiration for the famous statue which was transported to the 2010 Shanghai World Expo and is a true symbol to the Danish people. **Amalienborg**, your next stop is considered as one of the greatest works of Danish Rococo decoration. Constructed in the 1700's, the architecture consists of four identical palaces connected by a square. If you are lucky you will see the ceremonial changing of the guards, an event that happens every afternoon. The **Hans Christian Andersen Boulevard** leads to a statue of this notable writer on the City Square. The Danish fairy tale writer known for stories as "The Ugly Duckling" and "The Little Mermaid" had an important motto: "To travel is to live". He spent 43 years traveling abroad, gathering inspiration for his fairy tales and stories from his time overseas. After lunch you continue driving towards Stockholm.

*Overnight stay in Jönköping or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

### [Monday] Jönköping → Stockholm (320 km)

After breakfast, you continue your way to the capital of Sweden, Stockholm. Built on 14 islands in the Baltic Sea, this city is crowned the most beautiful of all Nordic cities. After lunch, we embark on a city tour that includes the **City Hall of Stockholm (Stadshuset)**, one of the most beautiful and well-known buildings in the world with inside the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm, the venue of the yearly **Nobel Banquet**. From the **Blue Hall**, guests are invited up a stairway to the **Golden Hall** (Gyllene salen) to dance. The walls of the Golden Hall are covered with more than 18 million glass and gold mosaic pieces, the artwork of artist Einar Forseth. The venue attracts close to 400,000 visitors a year. The tour continues with visits to the old **Parliament building**, **Vasa warship** and the **Storkyrkan Cathedral**.

*Overnight stay in Stockholm or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

**[Tuesday] Stockholm → Lillehammer (610 km)**

Today, the coach departs to Norway's largest lake, Mjøsa, famous for hosting the 1994 Winter Olympics. Another impressive feature is its rich stocks of top quality fish. Wander around with a grant feeling of space that contributes to the calm and vast natural winter scenery. You arrive in the evening and stay overnight in Lillehammer or city nearby. **Please note we will not visit the city Lillehammer.**

*Overnight stay in Lillehammer or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

**[Wednesday] Lillehammer → Briksdal Glacier → Sogndal (500 km)**

In the morning, you travel to the European continent's largest Glacier, **Briksdal** in Norway which covers 800 m<sup>2</sup>, is at its deepest 400 meters below sea level and at the highest point 2,000 meters above sea level. Surrounding the glacier is the **Jostedalbreen National Park**, where you embark on open troll-cars to admire the wildlife, clear streams, raging rivers and waterfalls. The ride will last for half an hour, after your group enjoys some leisure time to take pictures and see the **Briksdal glacier** up close. In the afternoon we head south towards Gudvangen. *Overnight stay in Sogndal or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

**[Thursday] Sogndal → Sognefjord Cruise → Flåm (150 km)**

After breakfast, the coach goes on to **Gudvangen dock** where the group joins the **Sognefjord Cruise** to explore Sognefjord, the world's longest and deepest fjord, an unparalleled spectacle by Mother Nature. After spending two hours among intoxicating scenery, the sightseeing boat arrives in Flåm. After lunch, you travel on one of the most beautiful railways, the **Flåmsbana**. This exciting railway attracts visitors from all over the world, as the scenery includes beautiful fjords, waterfalls, and valleys. After the ride, you return to the hotel for dinner. *Overnight stay in Flåm or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

**[Friday] Flåm → Oslo (300 km)**

Today, you depart to the Norwegian capital of Oslo. Every year on the 10th of December this city hosts the Nobel peace prize award to commemorate the passing of Founder-Inventor Alfred Nobel. Unlike the other four prizes awarded in Stockholm, Sweden, the **Nobel Peace Prize award ceremony** is held in Oslo. You continue with a visit to the famous **Vigeland Sculpture Park**, located inside the Frogner grounds.

On display are over 212 bronze and granite statues. The theme of the park is the human condition, illustrating relationships between men and women, adults and children. Not to be missed!

*Overnight stay in Oslo or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

**[Saturday] Oslo → Gothenburg → Copenhagen (580 km)**

In the morning, the coach heads south for the **Port of Gothenburg**, a major port in Western Europe. On **Götaplatsen** is Swedish sculptor Carl Milles' seven-metre-high statue of the sea god Poseidon, which caused quite a stir when it was unveiled in 1931. Also, a must-visit destination is the fish market hall, **Feskekôrka**, ('fish church' in Swedish), an indoor fish and shellfish market where you can buy all kinds of seafood delicacies caught on the day. You conclude your city tour at the **Gothenburg Cathedral** (Domkyrkan Göteborg), the seat of the bishop of Gothenburg in the Church of Sweden. The journey continues south to arrive in the evening in Copenhagen.

*Optional: if post-hotel is chosen, overnight stay in Copenhagen or city nearby (minimum 3\* hotel)*

### A. MAKING A RESERVATION

- (1) Please complete all the information in the booking form.
- (2) Passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the day you arrive at your destination.

### B. TOUR FARE INCLUDES

- (1) Hotel accommodation in a comfortable 3-star hotel, twin room with private facilities.
- (2) Daily continental breakfast.
- (3) The services of an experienced tour manager
- (4) Sightseeing and orientation tours included in the itinerary.
- (5) Daily transportation on modern air-conditioned coaches.
- (6) Professional coach driver.

## C. INSURANCE

- (1) Purchase of European travel insurance is strongly recommended. Please ensure that you are suitably insured for your entire trip.

## ADDITIONAL PASSENGER INFORMATION

- (1) Our professional tour managers will help you to explore and make the most out of your time. Their love and knowledge for the destinations will bring the holiday to life. The gratuity for the tour manager and driver is not included in the tour price. Our mandatory gratuity is €7 per person per day (€5 for the tour manager and €2 for the driver) both for adults and children. Gratuity will be collected by the tour manager in cash (Euros) whilst on tour.
- (2) Please present the voucher to the tour manager when you board the coach. goEUgo cannot be held liable for delay or expenses incurred due to passenger's negligence, causing them to miss the pick-up at the designated joining point. For any serious incidents please call our emergency number.
- (3) Please remember to pack any prescribed medication, motion sickness medication, and other essentials for personal use.
- (4) Please ensure that you have sufficient cash to pay for entrance tickets at your own expense as per the optional price lists, meals, tips, city taxes/entrance fees and expenses not included in our tour price and itinerary.
- (5) Please don't bring any illegal contraband goods into or smuggle items forbidden by law out of each country you are visiting. goEUgo will not be held liable and any losses, expenses. Fines are the responsibility of the passengers.
- (6) Whilst every effort is made to operate this tour as advertised, on occasion it may be necessary to make changes to the accommodation, the routing or order of an itinerary. Compensation will not be payable for alterations to the itinerary or nightly accommodation
- (7) For minors under 18 years of age, pregnant women or elderly (70+) are obliged to be accompanied by at least one (under 65) adult relative or friend. Please note: passengers (pregnant women or elderly people) need to sign the "Participation Commitment Disclaimer" for the protection of both parties. We also strongly recommend (pregnant women or elderly people) to purchase the necessary insurance before the tour.

## TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

- (1) It is the customer's responsibility to ensure he/she (all members of their party) is in possession of all the necessary travel and health documents before departure.
- (2) It is also the customer's responsibility to ensure that he/she (all members of their party) complies with all the necessary Visa, Passport or other travel regulations required for the countries they will be visiting. goEUgo will not be liable if your customers fail to do so and are refused entry or delayed. ## TOUR VOUCHERS

Once you have forwarded all the travel vouchers to your customers, please remind them they must take printed copies of all the vouchers and present these to the tour manager, hotel and transfer service. Failure to do so may prevent them from travelling with goEUgo, and goEUgo will not be held liable for any financial loss.

## MEALS

Daily continental breakfast is included in the tour price, for all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour manager will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants/café.



## **LUGGAGE**

The customer will be responsible for all their personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, please advise your customers that they must be prepared to carry their own suitcase from the coach to their hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of their luggage from the coach. Every client is only allowed to bring one luggage on board (Weight below 30kg, the sum of three sizes must not exceed 158 cm). If client bring more than one luggage (if the coach has enough space) we will have to charge 5 Euros every day for each additional luggage. Apologies for any inconveniences caused.

## **MOBILITY**

Because goEUgo cannot provide individual assistance to travellers during the tours and our coaches are not equipped with wheelchair access, unfortunately our tours are currently not suitable for wheelchair users and those less mobile.

## **SMOKING**

Smoking is not permitted on coaches provided by goEUgo. Smoking is also banned in some cafes', restaurants and public places in Europe. Please remind your customers to be aware of this law throughout the tour.

## **SAFETY**

Your customers' safety whilst on tour with goEUgo is a top priority of ours. We use experienced and professional coach drivers, so your customers will have a smooth and comfortable journey. To ensure your customers stay safe while on tour, kindly inform them of these simple precautions:
