Day 1 Rome

Rest of the day free to explore this Romantic city .Overnight at Hotel.

Day 5 **Venice**

Breakfast at Hotel. In the morning make your own way to the Tourist Office, Plaza San Marcos by 0900hrs. Join a **Guided Walking Tour of Venice** (SIC Basis). This interesting tour is centred around the history of St. Mark's Square and its main monuments. Make your own way to the starting point of your **Hop On Hop Off Frankfurt City Tour**. Frankfurt is located on the River Main and is the financial capital of Continental Europe and the Transportation Centre of Germany. Frankfurt is home of the European Central Bank and the German Stock Exchange. Additionally, it hosts some of the world's most important trade shows, such as the Frankfurt Auto Show and the Frankfurt Book Fair. The City is known for its futuristic skyline and the biggest airport in Germany. At the City Centre, one finds our start point at St. Paul's Church/Paulskirche, the historical Römer, Frankfurt Cathedral and the Goethe-House all within close proximity to one another, yet still within sight of the modern banking district. The tour lasts for 1 hour. Later return to your Hotel on your own. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 10 **Frankfurt – Amsterdam**

Breakfast at Hotel. Make your own way to Frankfurt Train Station to connect to your train to Amsterdam (Standard Class Train Ticket Included). Make your own way to your Hotel. Check in Hotel. Proceed on your own to Central Station where you tour will start. **Discover the City with Hop On Hop Off Amsterdam Tour** with 9 stops, located about the City. All included train travel will be in Standard Class and air travel will be in Economy Class normally on Budget Carriers.
