Day 1	KLIA/KUALA LUMPUR Arrival KLIA, transfer to Hotel for check in. Free and easy at pax own arrangement. Overnight at the hotel in Kuala Lumpur.	
Day 2	KUALA LUMPUR Proceed for Putrajaya Tour. After tour, lunch at pax own account. After above tour, transfer to Kuala Lumpur & proceed for Night Tour with Dinner which you will be having dinner at renowned restaurant and will be entertained by cultural performance along with music and dance. Overnight at the hotel in Kuala Lumpur.	Breakfast Dinner

Last is tour along Jonker Street. Enjoy the many kinds of local and delicious food available almost everywhere in Malacca. Overnight at the hotel in Kuala Lumpur.	Breakfast Lunch
Day 5	KUALA LUMPUR / CAMERON HIGHLANDS Proceed to Cameron Highlands which is famous for its world- renowned tea and its sprawling tea plantation. Take the Tapah exit and leave the Highway. Suggested visit en route: the Lata Iskandar Waterfall which is about 25 km from Tapah on the way to the Highlands. Overnight at the resort in Cameron Highlands. <i>NOTE: The temperature in Cameron Highlands is around 15-18 degrees. Bring along a jacket!</i>	Breakfast

Day 6	CAMERON HIGHLANDS Proceed for Countryside Tour at Cameron Highlands which include vegetable and strawberry farms, the Butterfly Garden, the local market, the tea plantations and the tea factory. The easiest estate to visit is BOH's Sungai Palas Estate, north of Brinchang off the road to Gunung Brinchang. Stop for lunch at a local restaurant on pax account. Overnight at the resort in Cameron Highlands.	Breakfast
Day 7	CAMERON HIGHLANDS / PENANG Transfer to Penang from Cameron Highlands At night, proceed to the Scenic Night Tour. Visit the city of George Town. As Penang is famous for its local cuisine, your evening will begin with the local cuisine dinner. After dinner, you will take on a short Trishaw ride. Then we will proceed on a scenic drive to cross the Penang Bridge, and back to Penang Island by ferry. Overnight at the hotel in Penang.	Breakfast
Day 8	PENANG ISLAND Proceed for City Explorer Tour. Tours included a stop at Fort Cornwallis (pax account). You will drive through Street Harmony, which houses the Anglican Church, Kuan Yin Chinese temple, Mahamariamman Indian temple and the Kapitan Keling Mosque. Followed by a visit to the state Museum, built in 1821, which houses a fine collection of old photographs, maps, charts and pass by colorful Little India and Chinatown. Lunch at own expenses. Next stop, the world's fourth largest Reclining Buddha statue at Wat Chayamangkalaram. After that, proceed to Hill and Temple Sightseeing Tour. Visit Kek Lok Si temple – one of the largest Buddhist temples in South East Asia. It's known as the temple of Ten Thousand Buddhas. A beautiful Bronze statue of Goddess of Mercy overlooks the temple. Next, take the funicular train to Penang Hill and elevation of 833m above sea level at below for a panoramic view of Georgetown and experience flora and fauna. Overnight at the hotel in Penang.	Breakfast
Day 9	PENANG / PENANG AIRPORT Free and easy. Check out from the hotel. Transfer to Penang Airport for next flight.	Breakfast
