
## 4 Days Yangon – Bagan – Yangon



Arrival at Yangon International Airport. Welcome by our well-experienced guide. Upon arrival, Visit to City center landmark Sule Pagoda, Mahabandoola Park and downtown of Yangon with remarkable sites of Colonial Buildings & City Hall. Visit to Chaukhtat Gyi, the biggest colossal reclining image in Myanmar.Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch transfer to hotel check in. In the afternoon, visit to Shwedagon Pagoda - described by Somerset Maugham: "The Shwedagon rose superb, glistening with its gold, like a sudden hope in the dark night of the soul of which the mystics write, glistening against the fog and smoke of the thriving city." This massive bell-shaped stupa rises nearly 100 meters above its hill-top surroundings. Wander through this magnificent structure and its courtyards, stupas, bells, temples, and Buddha images, and see religious and secular visitors from all parts of the globe. Shwedagon has become the symbol of Myanmar. **Over-night at Hotel in Yangon**.



After breakfast at hotel, transfer to the airport for morning flight to Bagan. Arrive Bagan and visit. Bagan, one of Asia's most popular archaeological destinations and one out of two most pre-eminent religious old cities in South East Asia. The sightseeing starts with a visit to; Pyathatgyi (Pyathadar ) Temple. Pyathatgyi is one of the few remaining "double cave" monasteries and was built in the first half of the 13th century. Dhamanyangyi Temple - built by King Narathu in 12th century which displayed the finest brickwork in Bagan. Sulamani Temple. In the afternoon visit to the lacquer ware factory followed by a visit to local village. After that visit to Ananda Temple – one of the masterpieces surviving and remaining in Bagan and considered to be in the Mon architecture style; Thatbyinnyu Temple- the highest building on the Bagan plain, Shwegugyi Temple, the Palace site. Then visit to the hill to watch the sunset **Overnight at hotel in Bagan**.

Day 3 : Bagan (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)



After breakfast at hotel visit Nyaung U Market, Shwezigon Pagoda (the prototype for later Myanmar Stupas), Kyansittha Umin, Wet-Kyi-Inn Gubyaukgyi Temple with its exquisite mural painting from the 13th Century, and Htilominlo Temple. After lunch, visit a fascinating lacquerware workshop before continuing on to Manuha Temple, built by the exiled King Manuha, before stopping at Nanphaya, said to have been the residence of King Manuha. You will also visit Ananda Temple, an architectural masterpiece, as well as the Oakkyaung Monastery, which is decorated with multi-colored mural paintings. Then transfer to airport to fly back to Yangon.Arrive Yangon and transfer to restaurant for dinner.After dinner transfer to hotel check in. **Overnight at Hotel in Yangon**.



After breakfast at hotel, visit to Bogyoke Market, the most famous for shopping with full of Myanmar arts, Handicrafts, Lacquerware & Jewelleries. (Close on every Monday & gazette holiday). Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch transfer to airport for departure to your next destination.
