
7 Days Yangon – Mandalay – Amarapura – Saggaing – Mingun – Bagan – Yangon

Day 01: Arrival Yangon -City tour (D)

Upon arrival to Yangon international airport , welcome by our guide and visit downtown area to see Sule pagoda located on a roundabout in downtown Yangon ,Yangon City Hall of Myanmar architectural design ,High Court noted for its British colonial architecture including its red-bricked exterior . Visit to Kandawgyi Royal Park and photo stop at Karaweik palace , a royal barge in the form of Karaweik (mythical bird) built in 1972 in the Kandawgyi Royal Lake .Visit to the magnificent Shwedagon pagoda, the massive bell-shaped golden spire covered with 60 tons of gold plates . Enshrined with the Lord Buddha's eight hairs relic, built over 2500 years ago. The most highlight and the holiest site in Myanmar.

Dinner at local restaurant and Overnight at Yangon.



Morning after breakfast , visit to **Kyaukhtatgyi Buddha Image** - houses the fourth largest colossal reclining Buddha .You can study traditional wood carving workshops along the stairways this pagoda .If you wish , shopping in the **Bogyoke market** formerly "Scott market", where you can get a wide range of Myanmar handicraft, jewelries, fabrics, lacquer wares and so on (Note : Market is closed on Mondays and public holidays) . **China town market** and a colorful Chinese temple. It will be followed by **visit to Saint Mary's cathedral** which is the biggest Catholic Church in Myanmar. After lunch , drive to Mandalay . Yangon to Mandaly driving hours take about 8 ~ 9 hours.

Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants and Overnight at Mandalay.

Day 03: Mandalay - Amarapura (B/L/D)

Morning after breakfast, visit **Amarapura ancient city**, walking on the longest old teak bridge then visit **Mahagandayone monastery** the discipline Htayrawada Buddhist monastery, which you can learn life's of the Buddhist monks in the monastery. Jade Pagoda - **The Kyauksein(Jade) Pagoda** in Amarapura township includes more than 10,000 tonnes of the precious gemstone and is being built at an estimated cost of K10 billion (US\$10.3 million). They are about 1000 monks living in this monastery. Then visit to **Mahamuni temple** enshrined with the 2500 years old Bronze Buddha image. The city wall and the moat about 2 km in each side is welcome you in Mandalay to your sightseeing place such as , **Shwe kyaung temple** "the exquisite wooden temple" , **Atumashi temple** "the incomparative temple", **Kuthodaw pagoda** " the largest collection of Buddhist inscription" and the **Mandalay hill** where you can see the overview of the Mandalay city and the beautiful sunset.

Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants and Overnight at Mandalay .

Day 04 : Mandalay – Saggaing - Mingun – Night drive to Bagan (B/L/D)

Morning after breakfast, set out from Mandalay for visit **Sagaing Hill** where over 600 monasteries for monks and nuns are located for Buddhist studies and meditation. Visit **Kaungmudaw Pagoda** a huge pagoda in 46 m (151 feet) high and in the shape of a perfect hemisphere, **U min Thonze** or thirty caves pagoda has many Buddha images in a crescent shaped colonnade, **Ywahtaung Village** where you can see silver workers producing bowls and other silver items by traditional methods and the most impressive **Soon Oo Pon Nya Shin Pagoda** nearby. Take a private boat to **Mingun**. That is famous for its huge and incomplete **Pahtodawgyi Pagoda** built by King Bodaw (Badon) in 1791 and **Mingun Bell** the biggest hanging bell in the world. Afterwards, visit the **Hsinbyume Pagoda or Mya Thein Tan**











Pagoda, which architectural style is pretty different from other pagodas in Myanmar. The pagoda also belongs to one

of the most photogenic attractions. Then, dinner at local restaurant and night drive to Bagan. Mandalay to Bagan driving hours take about 4 hours.

Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants and Overnight at Bagan.

Day o5: Bagan Full Day Sightseeing (B/L/D)

Early morning, arriva to Bagan. Hotel Check in & take a rest. After breakfast, full day excursion by car start with Nyaun U Market, Nyaung Oo Market, Shwezigone Pagoda - in which an emerald image of the Buddha from

China and the Frontlet Relic of Buddha were enshrined, Gubyaukgyi Temple - is noted for its wall paintings, Htilominlo Pagoda - one of the largest temples of Bagan is noted for its fine plaster carvings, Ananda Temple - the finest, largest and best preserved of all the Bagan temples, Thatbyinnyu Pagoda - Bagan's tallest temple at almost 217 ft, **Shwesandaw pagoda** - is a graceful white pyramid-style pagoda with steps leading past five terraces to the circular stupa top, with good 360-degree views ,Dhammayangyi Pagoda - extending approximately 255 feet on each of its four sides, is Bagan's most massive shrine, Gadawt Palin Pahto - Bagan's second tallest and most imposing of the Bagan temples, Bupaya or Bu Pagoda - situated right on the river bank of the Avevarwaddy was a favorite place . Sunset by boat on the Ayeyarwaddy Pagoda . Dinner at local restaurant with puppet Show.

Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants and Overnight at Mandalay.

Note: 2018 Update: It is not permitted to climb the Bagan temples as of January 2018. There are some artificial hills/mounds which have good sunrise and sunset views.



If you want to feel Bagan Sunrise, our driver pick you up from hotel at (5 or 5:30) am and transfer to one of the artificial hills/mounds which have good sunrise. Then, transfer back to hotel. After your breakfast, Nathlaung Kyaung, the only remaining Hindu temple in Bagan, Myazedi Pagoda, well known for its stone inscription which, was engraved in 4 language as in Myanmar, Mon, Pali, and Pyu on 4 sides of a stone. **Kyansitthar Umin**, the tunnel was built in the late thirteenth century, Nagayon Pagoda was built at the end of the 11th century and it resembles the Indian temples of the area of Orissa. Abeyatanar Pagoda, famous for paintings that cover the inner walls. Then visit Nga-kywe-na-daung Pagoda, early Pyu type brick masonry stupa. After Lunch, drive back to Yangon. Bagan to Yangon driving hours take about 8~9

Lunch & Dinner at local restaurants and Overnight at Yangon.

Day 07: Yangon - Departure (B)

Morning after breakfast, transfer to airport for departure.
