Top 10 Indoor Gardens of the World

Featuring more than 1 million plants from more than 5,000 species, **Gardens by the Bay** is a must-see destination filled with wonders from around the world. Marvel at the 35-metre tall indoor waterfall and stroll above the jungle canopy via aerial walkways at **Cloud Forest**. Replicating the cool and dry Mediterranean climate, **Flower Dome** showcases exotic plants from 5 continents in 9 different gardens. Watch as the Supertrees come alive with special effects at night. Come, be inspired by nature where wonder blooms.

Sunflower Surprise (31 Aug – 21 Oct 2018)

The road to the Emerald City in the timeless tale of The Wonderful Wizard of Oz is paved in yellow – and in the "Sunflower Surprise" floral display, this is creatively reinterpreted as a profusion of sunflowers. Amidst more than 10,000 sunflowers of various shapes and sizes, our heroine Dorothy and her faithful dog Toto find their way to the Wizard's castle. Along the way, the pair meet allies-turned-loyal friends Scarecrow, Tin Man and Cowardly Lion.

Pixie dust fills the air as Disney Tsum Tsum brings a touch of magic to the Christmas floral display at Gardens by the Bay. It's time to get the fairy lights and festive baubles ready as Mickey and his Tsum Tsum pals stack up to decorate the tallest live Christmas tree in Flower Dome. In this special floral display, Olaf feels right at home amidst a snowy landscape of poinsettias, Christmas berries and holly, while Chip and Dale load up the sleigh with presents and Dumbo prepares to take flight.
