

Royal Caribbean Cruises : Quantum of the Seas - ICA Requirements For Residents

Singapore Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) has various restrictions for non-residents (cruise to nowhere - CTNW) and below has been shared by ICA Cruise Team:

1. In general, short term visit pass (STVP) holders are not allowed for the CTNW according to prevailing policy.
2. Besides Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents (PR), valid long term pass holders, such as work permit holders, employment pass holders, dependant pass (DP) holders, student pass holders, long-term pass holders are allowed on CTNW
3. Some actual cases who were **not** eligible for the cruise that we had encountered so far, are PR with expired re-entry permit, cancelled DP holders, cancelled work pass holders (who are on special passes- which are considered short-term passes), and expired long-term pass holders.

Note :

- **Sailing closes 5 days prior to sail date**
- **Anyone who has travelled outside Singapore 14 days or less prior to sail date will be denied boarding**
- **If guests have been tested positive for COVID 180 days prior to sail date, they will also be denied boarding**
