Royal Caribbean Cruises : Quantum of the Seas - ICA Requirements For Residents

Singapore Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) has various restrictions for non-residents (cruise to nowhere - CTNW) and below has been shared by ICA Cruise Team:

- In general, short term visit pass (STVP) holders are not allowed for the CTNW according to prevailing policy.
- Besides Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents (PR), <u>valid</u> long term pass holders, such as work permit holders, employment pass holders, dependant pass (DP) holders, student pass holders, long-term pass holders are allowed on CTNW
- 3. Some actual cases who were **not** eligible for the cruise that we had encountered so far, are PR with expired re-entry permit, cancelled DP holders, cancelled work pass holders (who are on special passes- which are considered short-term passes), and expired long-term pass holders.

Note :

- Sailing closes 5 days prior to sail date
- Anyone who has travelled outside Singapore 14 days or less prior to sail date will be denied boarding
- If guests have been tested positive for COVID 180 days prior to sail date, they will also be denied boarding
