

Visa to Indonesia



Indonesian visa on arrival (VOA)

Passport holders of the following countries visiting Indonesia for the purpose of tourism, business, social, cultural, government or official visits are allowed to obtain a visa on arrival and to stay in Indonesia for up to 30 days and can extend for 1 time for 30 days.

Visitors should be in possession of valid passport with minimum of 6 months validity and a return or an onward journey ticket at the time of arrival.

Visa on arrival can be obtained for the following nationalities:

- US\$ 25 per person for VOA applicable for a stay not exceeding 30 continuous days.
